








- 27 national professional associations representing over 50.000 individual members across Europe

- The PE on Education was established in 2011 and intends to deal with educational matters in geology (earth sciences) at all education levels from primary school to postgraduate courses.
 - Basic Knowledge of Earth science is essential to meeting the environmental challenges in natural resources.
 - Main scope: a)promote Geoscience education to public for understanding the causes and potential societal consequences of natural Earth processes. b)to explore the importance, methods, challenges, and future directions of geoscience education.
